

1. Mr. Rajendra B. Ghumare, Mr. Sunil K. Shinde and Derde Korhale Gram Panchayat, Taluka Kopargaon, District Ahmednagar filed a Petition dated 03/07/2019 before this Authority in the matter of Marathwada Water Grid sought to be established by the State Government contrary to the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority Act, 2005.

The Petitioners are depending upon Darna Complex for their drinking and agriculture needs because of acute shortage of water in their rain shadow area. Any release from Darna Dam will affect drinking water



demand of the Petitioners. As huge quantity of water flows in the Arabian Sea unutilized, the Hon'ble High Court at Bombay in PIL No. 170/2013, vide order dated 23/09/2016, directed to divert water from Konkan area to Godavari Basin. However, the pace of work on this diversion of water is very slow but the work of water grid is being taken at supersonic speed. Unless and until water is made available, it is futile exercise to undertake water grid project. Therefore, the Petitioner mainly prayed to restrain the Respondents from implementing the project of Marathwada Water Grid for entire districts in Marathwada Region unless and until 80 TMC water is diverted from Konkan Region to Godavari Basin.

- 3. After filing of the Petition on 23/07/2019, the matter could not be taken up due to the Covid-19 pandemic and vacancy of post of Chairperson and Members of the Authority. The Authority vide its letter dated 15/01/2020 and 07/09/2022 directed all the Respondents to file Para wise Affidavit in Reply within four weeks. However, none of the Respondents complied.
- 4. The Authority conducted first hearing in the matter on 04/05/2023. During the hearing, the Authority stated that the present matter is at pre-admission stage and issue of jurisdiction of this Authority needs to be decided first and directed the Petitioner to file an Affidavit in this regard.
- After receipt of the Petitioner's Affidavit dated 17/05/2023, the Authority conducted second and final hearing on 22/06/2023. During the hearing, Adv. Amol G. Vasmatkar, on behalf of Respondent No. 4, filed an Affidavit in Reply dated 21/06/2023 and copies were given to all parties. Adv. Vasmatkar submitted that Marathwada Water Grid project is only for domestic water supply at first stage and is still at planning stage.

During the hearing, Adv. R. L. Kute could not justify that the Authority has jurisdiction as per the provisions of Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority Act, 2005. Considering the Affidavit filed by the Respondent No. 4 and after taking instructions from the Petitioner,





Adv. R. L. Kute submitted that Petitioner would like to withdraw the Petition with liberty to file a fresh Petition.

ORDER

- 7. Having heard the parties to the litigation, perusing documents as well as data on record, submissions made by the parties and relevant provisions under Regulation 29 of the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority (Conduct of Business) Regulations 2013, this Authority orders as under;
 - (a) The Petitioner is hereby allowed to withdraw the petition.
 - (b) The Petition under Case No. 17 of 2019 is disposed of with no order as to the costs.
