ORDER

CORAM: Smt. CHITKALA ZUTSHI, MEMBER (Economy) Shri. S.V.SODAL, MEMBER (Engineering)

Date: 25 November 2015

An Application was received from Executive Director (ED), Maharashtra Krishna Valley Development Corporation (MKVDC), Pune for Review of MWRRA's Order dated 27/10/2015 regarding releasing water from Kukadi Complex into Ghod Dam on various issues mentioned in his application. The main issues raised in the application are,

- a) Kukadi project & 66 K T weirs and Ghod project each has an individual existence, administrative approval, its own dependability of yield, water use & own cropping pattern. Therefore these projects should not be clubbed together with Kukadi project for calculating percentage of utilizable water.
- b) Available percentage of utilizable water including Kharif use as on 15/10/2015 is mainly dependent on yield received at Dam site. This is calculated from Dam storage and water use. The consideration in the award based on storage as on 15/10/2015 was incorrect. It should have been based on actual yield received in each dam site.
- c) There are no Government Resolutions (GR) which substantiates the definitions of Scarcity & Distress. The MKVDC, Pune is of the opinion that it is prerogative of Government to define Scarcity and Distress by way of Rules or GR
- d) Practical difficulty to apply 20% cut to Rabi.

2 Hearing on 24/11/2015

- b) The ED, MKVDC, Pune's Advocate briefed the Authority about the background of application. He has proposed a review of the MWWRA's order 27/10/2015 for release form Dimbhe dam & Yedgaon dam on the basis of issues raised.
- c) Advocate Palande and Advocate of Shri. Devdatta Nikam strongly objected to the hearing of the review of MWRRA's Order dated 27/10/2015 regarding releasing water from Kukadi Complex into Ghod Dam on the ground that there is stay given for release of water till 17/11/2015 by the Hon'ble High Court at Mumbai on 05/11/2015. The matter was again heard by the Hon'ble High Court on 17/11/2015, wherein stay was further continued till 16/03/2016.

3. Analysis with Reasons and Direction

The Hon'ble High Court has directed in it order dated 05/11/2015 in the Civil Writ Petition (St.) 30771 of 2015 filed by Shri. Devdatta Nikam as under,

- 2. In the communication dated 31/10/2015 it is informed to the Collector, Police Superintendent and Chief Engineer that the water shall be released on 16/11/2015 or thereafter, from Dimbhe and Yedgoan dams.
- 3. In view of this put up this matter on 17/11/2015 and till then the water shall not be released

Further this matter was again heard on 17/11/2015 and following order was issued and next date of hearing was given as 16/03/2016.

If in any of the above matters, ad-interim relief or interim relief is operative till today, the same will continue to operate till the respective next dates. If ad-interim relief is not granted for a limited period, the said orders will remain unaffected."

The Hon'ble High Court has stayed the release of water from Dimbhe dam (18 Mm³) and Yedgoan dam (27 Mm³) as per the MWRRA's Order dated 27/10/2015.

We feel the present review application cannot be entertained in view of the above mentioned stay order.

The application for review of MWRRA Order dated 27/10/2015 is hereby dismissed.
